



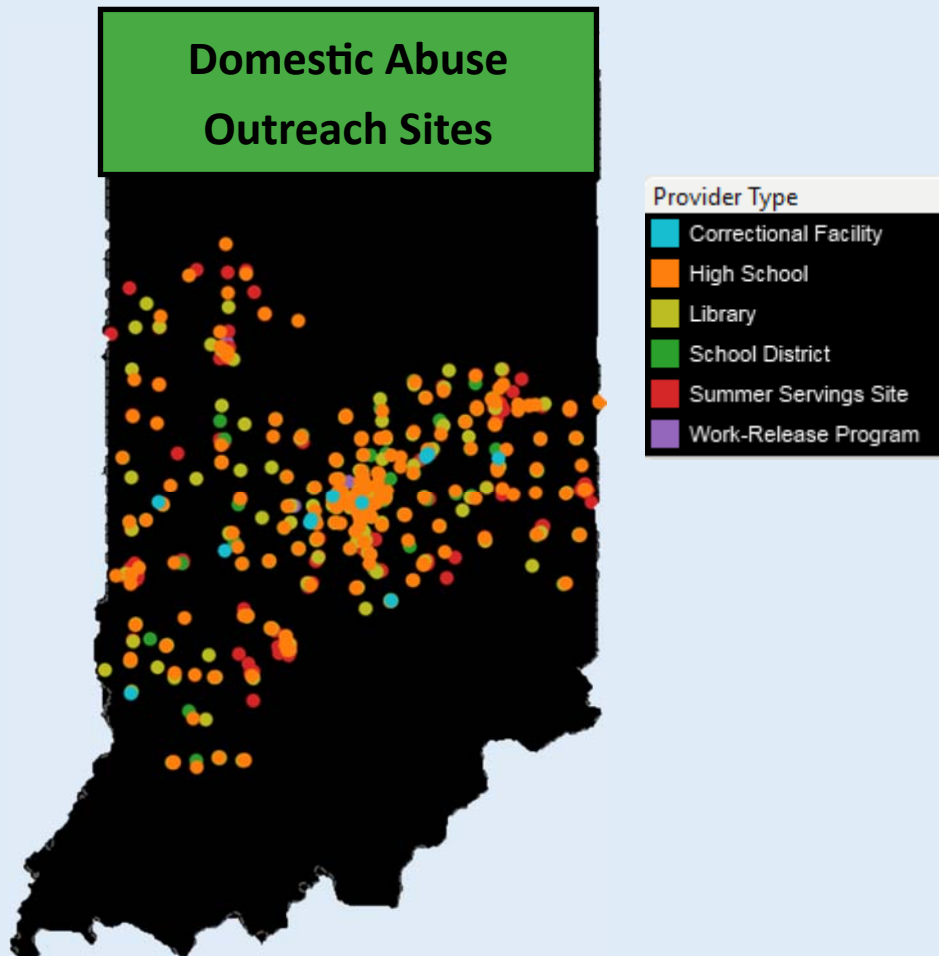
Connect2Help211 Provides Access to Resources for Domestic Violence Victims

Connect2Help211 has responded to calls for help from nearly **4,400 people** involved in a domestic abuse situation in the last 12 months (from May of 2014 to April of 2015). There also were nearly **1,200 domestic abuse-related searches** on our website (www.Connect2Help211.org). On average, 12 domestic violence victims call 211 everyday. Most of them are looking for a **safe place** to stay, **counseling** to help deal with the situation, or **legal assistance** to protect themselves and their children. Connect2Help211 has operated the Domestic Violence Navigation Hub since November of 2003.

The service provides community resources information (such as shelter, counseling and legal resources)

24 hours a day, 365 days a year via an easy-to-remember number—211.

Domestic abuse takes place across every race, age, and socio-economic category. Unfortunately, many people involved in a domestic abuse situation (or their family or friends) do not know where to turn for help. With support from the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute*, Connect2Help211 has **reached out to more than 550 service providers in its 35-county service area**, providing printed materials that can be given to domestic abuse victims who need help.
